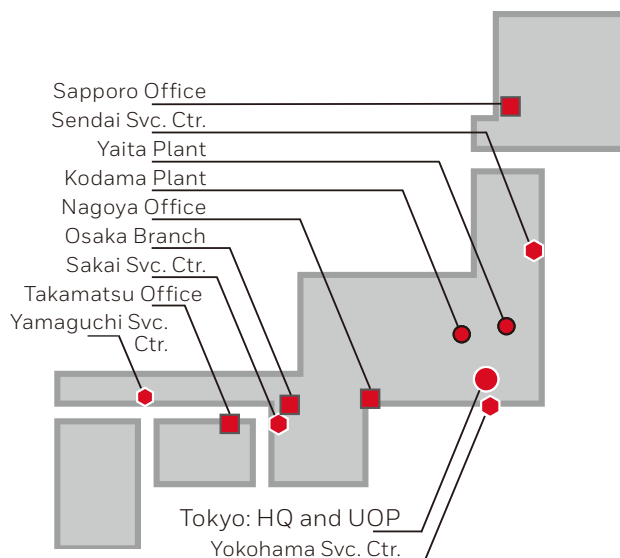

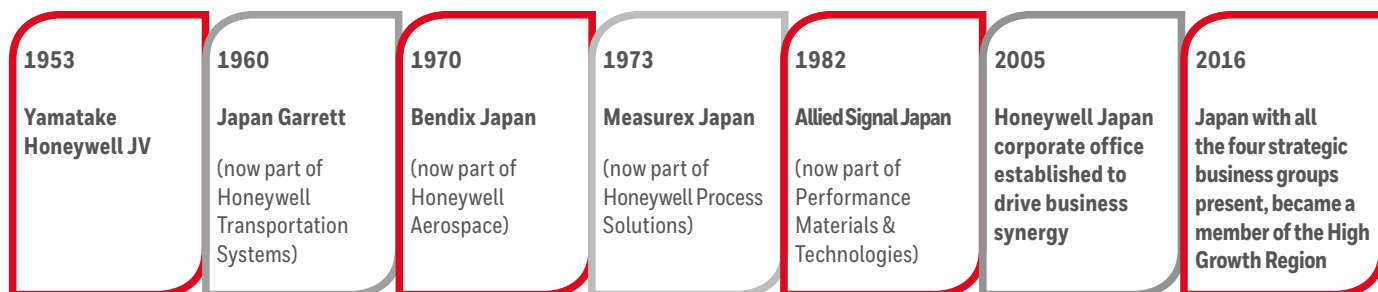

Honeywell's history in Japan can be traced back to the early 1900s when some instrumentation products were traded in Japan through Yamatake Shokai Co., Ltd. (now Azbil Trading Co. Ltd.). In 1953, a joint venture between Honeywell and Yamatake Keiki Co., Ltd. (now Azbil Corporation) was established to help accelerate industrial automation. As Japan continued to industrialize, Honeywell grew along with its Japanese customers, in both business size and product portfolio. Six decades later, all of Honeywell's strategic business groups are conducting business in Japan through their local offices with wide range of products from turbochargers, avionics, refineries and petrochemical plants, from electronic components, scanners and sensors, to pharmaceutical packaging films and ultra-low-GWP refrigerants and insulation foam-blowing materials. Nowadays, the company's growth strategy focuses on software capabilities, which represent a large portion of our growth over the next several years. By 2019, we will reduce our global greenhouse gas emissions by an additional 10 percent per dollar of revenue from our 2013 levels. We exceeded our first public goal to reduce global greenhouse gases by more than 30 percent and improve energy efficiency by more than 20 percent between 2004 and 2011. A second five-year goal, set to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by an additional 15 percent per dollar of revenue from 2011 levels, was met three years early.

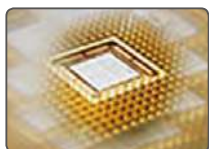
