

SUPPLEMENTAL PROVISIONS UNDER FIXED PRICE U.S. GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS [SPFFP]

The following provisions apply to any Contract or Purchase Order if the Contract or Purchase Order is subject to any provision or regulation applicable to a United States Government Contract. Supplier must include in each lower-tier subcontract and purchase orders the appropriate flow down clauses as required by the FAR and FAR Supplement clauses included in this Contract or Purchase order.

1. DEFINITIONS

Capitalized terms that are used but not defined in these Supplemental Provisions have the meanings given them in the Contract.

“**DFARS**” mean the Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement to the FAR

“**DEARS**” mean the Department of Energy Supplement to the FAR

“**DOE**” mean the Department of Energy

“**DHS**” means the Department of Homeland Security

“**FAR**” means the Federal Acquisition Regulation

“**HSAR**” means the Department of Homeland Security Supplement to the FAR

“**NASA**” means the National Aeronautics and Space Administration

“**NFS**” means the NASA Supplement to the FAR

2. AMENDMENTS REQUIRED BY PRIME CONTRACT

Supplier agrees that upon request of Honeywell it will negotiate in good faith with Honeywell relative to amendments to this Contract to incorporate additional provisions herein or to change provisions hereof, as Honeywell may reasonably deem necessary to comply with the provisions of the applicable prime contractor with the provisions of amendments to such Prime Contract. If any such amendment to this Contract causes an increase or decrease in the cost of, or the time required for, performance under this Contract, an equitable adjustment will be made pursuant to the “Changes” clause of this Contract.

3. PRESERVATION OF THE GOVERNMENT’S RIGHTS

If Honeywell furnishes designs, drawings, special tooling, equipment, engineering data, or other technical or Confidential Information (Furnished Items) which the Government owns or has the right to authorize the use of, nothing herein will be construed to mean that Honeywell acting on its own behalf, may modify or limit any rights the Government may have to authorize Supplier’s use of such Furnished Items in support of other U.S. Government prime contracts.

4. DISPUTES

If a dispute relates to a matter that would give Honeywell recourse against the Federal Government under its contracts, the following provisions applies:

- A. Supplier will give Honeywell a fully supported written claim within five (5) years after the claim accrues, but no later than final payment under the order. Supplier will fully cooperate with Honeywell in prosecuting any such dispute and will be bound by the outcome unless Honeywell discontinues its prosecution of the dispute or does not afford Supplier an opportunity to continue to prosecute the dispute in Honeywell’s name.
- B. For any claim that exceeds \$100,000, Supplier shall provide a certification in the form and signed by the appropriate official of the Supplier as required by the “Disputes” clause, FAR 52.233-1 (May 2014), as directed by Honeywell.

5. APPLICABLE LAW

Any provision that is (i) incorporated in full text or by reference from the Federal Acquisition Regulation (“FAR”), or (ii) incorporated in full text or by reference from any agency regulation that implements or supplements the FAR, or (iii) that is substantially based on any such agency regulation or FAR provision, will be construed and interpreted according to the federal common law of government contracts as enunciated and applied by federal judicial bodies, Boards of Contract Appeals, and quasi-judicial agencies of the federal Government.

Supplier acknowledges that Honeywell will rely upon Supplier's certifications and representations contained herein and in any written offer, proposal or quote, or company profile submission, which results in award of a contract to Supplier. By entering into such contract, Supplier republishes the certifications and representations submitted with its written offer and/or made annually, including company profile information, and oral offers/quotations made at the request of Honeywell, and Supplier makes these certifications and representations set forth below. Supplier will immediately notify Honeywell of any change of status regarding any certification or representation.

Supplier must provide immediate written notice to Honeywell if Supplier learns that its certification was erroneous when submitted or has become erroneous through changed circumstances.

7. INCORPORATION OF FAR AND DFARS CLAUSES

The FAR and DFARS clauses referenced below are incorporated herein by reference, with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text, and are applicable, including any notes following the clause citation, to this Contract. If the date or substance of any of the clauses listed below is different from the date or substance of the clause incorporated in the latest Prime Contract under which this Contract or Purchase Order is issued, the date or substance of the clause incorporated by said Prime Contract applies instead. Supplier agrees to comply with any revised versions of the Government contract clauses cited that are set forth in Honeywell's Prime Contract.

In all such clauses, unless otherwise specified, "the contract" means the Contract or Purchase Order, "Contractor" means Supplier, "Contracting Officer" means Honeywell, "Government" includes Honeywell to the extent necessary to enable Honeywell to administer this Contract or Purchase Order and to perform its obligations under its Prime Contract, and "subcontract(s)" and "subcontractor(s)" means Supplier's lower-tier subcontract(s) and subcontractor(s), respectively.

Seller shall include in each lower-tier subcontract the appropriate flow down clauses as required by FAR and DFARS.
